# Sustainability in the US and Europe

- Different trajectories in research and practice
  - both have their respective strengths and approaches
- European countries have been pursuing such goals for many years
- Has only been a strong requirement in the US in recent years
- Current strong drive in the US
- Compared to the slower-grown and more mature development in Europe



# **Main Objectives**

- Identify the main issues associated with the design, construction, & management of sustainable pavement systems
- Investigate means by which the level of sustainability of pavements and their constituent materials can be evaluated
- Determine the future research efforts that are needed to deliver continuing and increasing sustainability in the sector



## Main Objectives (cont.)

- Establish a 'Roadmap' for the development and implementation of more sustainable pavement engineering and management technologies and practices
  - Short-term
  - Medium-term
  - Long-term
- Determine the relative areas of strength and expertise in US and Europe
  - Foster international research collaboration that will benefit both regions.




# Why an Invitation-only Workshop?
