Conclusion

- For pavements, business as usual is NOT sustainable
- However, focused near-term research can/will provide practical, scientificallybased tools/solutions to effectively guide decision makers
- Strategic research in identified areas will provide the scientific answers necessary to support the green economy of the future

- Bring in airfield and local people
- Share information/coordinate with FHWA ETG & other agencies (EPA)

- Prepare some materials that can be used for education.
